Category	Privileges	Educational/Experience Requirements
A	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in Emergency Medicine.	• Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, OR • an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, OR • Certification from the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP) with successful completion of an EM accredited training program and subspecialty exam results pending or completed.
B	Procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment or training as approved by the Chief of the Department, including: Cardiac Arrest Coverage Emergency Department Targeted Ultrasonography	Certification and/or Fellowship as indicated in Category A, and additional training as defined and supported by the Chief of the Department
C	Privileges granted to physicians not certified in the specialty, but who have experience, training and demonstrated competence.
