| A | All activities and procedures generally performed by surgeons certified in Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery. | Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, or an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. |
| B | Procedures requiring the use of specialized training and/or equipment as approved by the Chief of the Department including: 1. Facial cosmetic surgery 2. Major head and neck surgery, including reconstructive surgery 3. Cochlear implants 4. Laser privileges 5. Robotic Surgery | Certification and Fellowship as indicated in Category A, and additional training as defined and supported by the Chief of the Department Certificate course, and/or Clinical Fellowship, supported by Chief of Department |
| C | Privileges granted to physicians not certified in the specialty, but who have experience, training and/or demonstrated competence. | |
