A	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in Emergency Medicine.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, OR• an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, OR• Certification from the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP) with successful completion of an EM accredited training program and subspecialty exam results pending or completed.
B	Procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment or training as approved by the Chief of the Department, including: Cardiac Arrest Coverage Emergency Department Targeted Ultrasonography	Certification and/or Fellowship as indicated in Category A, and additional training as defined and supported by the Chief of the Department
C	Privileges granted to physicians not certified in the specialty, but who have experience, training and demonstrated competence.
