NEUROSURGERY

Category	Privileges	Educational/Experience Requirements
A	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in Neurosurgery.	Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, or an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
B	Clinical Robotic Surgery	Individual must have a defined clinical and academic focus in minimally invasive surgery with a commitment to clinical or basic science research in the field including meaningful health technology assessment and outcomes research Approval from the Division or Department Chef necessary, and upon completion of appropriate training in robotic surgery.

Category	Privileges	Educational/Experience Requirements
A	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in Neurology.	Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, or an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.

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B	Procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment or training as approved by the Chief of the Department including: 1. EMG and nerve conduction studies 2. EEG	Certification and Fellowship as indicated in Category A, and additional training as defined and supported by the Chief of the Department
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
