<b>Category</b>	<b>Privileges</b>	<b>Educational / Experience Requirements</b>
<b>A</b>	All activities and procedures generally performed by surgeons who are certified in Ophthalmology.	Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario
<b>B</b>	Procedures requiring the use of specialized training and/or equipment as approved by the Chief of the Department including: 1. Retinal and vitreous surgery of the posterior segment 2. Major orbital surgery 3. Corneal transplantation	Certification and Fellowship as indicated in Category A, and additional training as defined and supported by the Chief of the Department.
<b>C</b>	Privileges granted to physicians not certified in the specialty, but who have experience, training and/or demonstrated competence.
