



## Delineation of Procedural Privileges Department of – Dentistry

## **Adult and Paediatrics**

Delineation	Privileges	Educational and Experience Requirements
A-DEN	All activities and procedures generally performed by individuals certified in Dentistry.	General or Academic Certificate in Dentistry from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario (RCDSO) or Specialist or Specialist Academic Certificate from the RCDSO
B-DEN	To include those dentists who do not have any surgical privileges	General or Academic Certificate in Dentistry from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario (RCDSO) or Specialist or Specialist Academic Certificate from the RCDSO
C-DEN	All activities and procedures generally performed by individuals certified in Dentistry.  Procedures requiring the use of specialized training and/or equipment as approved by the Chief of the Department including conscious sedation by oral, (inhalation – nitrous oxide) and intravenous routes.	Certification as indicated in Category A, and additional focused training in Dental Anesthesia from an accredited post-graduate program from an accredited dental institution.

## **Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery**

Delineation	Privileges	Educational and Experience Requirements
A-OMF	All activities and procedures generally performed by individuals certified in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery	Specialist or Specialist Academic Certificate from the RCDSO
B-OMF	All activities and procedures generally performed by individuals certified in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment and / or training as approved by the Chief of the Department, including:	Specialist or Specialist Academic Certificate from the RCDSO
	<ol> <li>Cosmetic oral and maxillofacial surgery</li> <li>Primary cleft and craniofacial surgery</li> <li>Maxillofacial reconstruction including the harvest and use of local &amp; regional flaps as well as distant tissue for non-vascularized maxillofacial reconstruction</li> </ol>	Fellowship Certification or mentorship/approval by the Chief or his/her delegate.
	4. Laser surgery	Proof of certification in accordance with Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standard Z386. Initial verification is confirmed by the LHSC Laser Safety Officer followed by bi-annual recertification.
