B-OBS	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in the specialty inclusive of Category A Delineation. S-GYN	 Those in a Surgical Assistant Role within the Gynaecology Surgery Program Only works under the direct supervision of a current ACTIVE Professional Staff Member in categories A-GYN and B-GYN in the Division of Gynaecology Surgery; May NOT be the most responsible physician; May be first assistant in the Operating Room; May write orders; 	Holds a valid Certificate of Registration from the CPSO.
LASER	Procedures requiring the use of lasers.	Provide proof of certification in accordance with the Canadian Standards Associate (CSA) standard Z386. Initial verification of certification is confirmed by the LHSC Laser Safety Officer followed by bi-annual recertification.
C-GYN	Perform specified procedures as noted: 1) Surgical assist in the operating room at LHSC and SJHC 2) Intrauterine inseminations at The Fertility Clinic, LHSC 3) Oocyte retrievals at The Fertility Clinic, LHSC 4) Embryo transfers at The Fertility Clinic, LHSC 5) Hysterosalpingograms at LHSC	Holds a valid Certificate of Registration from the CPSO and insured through the Canadian Medical Protection Association (CMPA). Holds Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
D-GYN	Perform hysterosalpingograms in the Radiology Department only at LHSC	Holds a valid Certificate of Registration from the CPSO and insured through the Canadian Medical Protection Association (CMPA). Holds Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
