

PossAbilities Program

The PossAbilities Program is one component of the rehabilitation continuum offered by Parkwood Hospital. PossAbilities is a resource centre for high technology assistive devices and disability products for clients in the Southwestern Ontario region. It is a fee for service program, typically funded on behalf of clients by third parties such as auto insurance companies, the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB), or private insurance.



What Services Do We Provide?

- Clinical and technical expertise of an interdisciplinary team regarding assistive devices and products
- Client focused collaborative approach to determine the needs and goals of the individual
- ▶ Professional assessment and advice on such aspects of independent living as adapted telephone systems, emergency response equipment, controls for entertainment and home appliances as well as computer access and more
- A resource centre of product catalogues and product samples for viewing and discussion
- Demonstrations of various devices and products
- ➤ Trial period of equipment to ensure identification of the most effective device for the client
