St. Joseph's Veterans Care Program General Visitor Policy Fact Sheet

Would you like to visit a resident at Parkwood Institute's Veterans Care Program? Please follow the guidelines below.

General visitors must pre-schedule their visits at least 24 hours in advance and can visit one resident per visit, once a week for up to one hour. These visits will occur outside or indoors in the Chapel.

• To arrange a visit with a veteran at Parkwood Institute, call the Veterans family line at 519-685-4292 extension 41405.

If you need to reschedule or cancel or visit, please provide as much notice as possible. All requests will be filled on a first come first serve basis or as per veteran/resident need.

To enter our building general visitors must:

- enter at the Western Counties Wing entrance
- be screened at the door for symptoms COVID-19 and travel/contact history.
 Only those who passed screening will be permitted to visit.
- 3. wear the sticker given to them at screening, while in the building.

- 4. Confirm with the screener they have:
 - had a COVID-19 test within the past 14 days and have received a negative result. (for indoor visits only)
 - ✓ not visited another resident who has COVID-19, is selfisolating or has symptoms of COVID-19
 - ✓ not visited another home that has a COVID-19 outbreak.

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To protect everyone general visitors must:

- wear the mask given to them at the entrance at all times
- clean their hands as they enter and leave the facility and before and after contact with the resident
- keep physically distant (at least 6 feet) from others. Close contact with the resident the visitor is visiting is allowed as long as the visitor has
- passed all screening, including having a negative COVID-19 test within the past two weeks. Both the resident and visitor must wear a mask when closer than 6 feet from each other.
- once a month, read this fact sheet and Guidelines for Safe Visits in Long-Term Care package and sign the Visitor Confirmation Sheet.

If at any time a visitor does not comply with the guidelines as outlined above, their visits may be suspended until further notice.

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
