Clinical Instructors and Pyxis Education

Pyxis Medstation Training

All Instructors of student groups will be required to have training and access to Pyxis in order to supervise nursing students in the complete process for closed loop medication administration.

Instructors of student groups will need to review the Pyxis Checklist to support their learning. New Instructors to St. Joseph's will also be required to attend an in-person demonstration of the system with one of the Professional Practice Consultants. Contact the Student Affairs Administrator to schedule in-person training.

Once the training is completed, Student Affairs will initiate Instructor access to the Pyxis system by sending documentation to Pharmacy, and the Professional Practice nurse will authorize this access. You will be able to gain access to pyxis via your Network login.

Returning Instructors are required to complete the on-line Pyxis learning annually.

Required e-learning & Declaration - Generally, Instructors of student groups must complete the same e-learning as the students they are teaching. The instructors will sign the declaration form that the e-learning has been completed and will sign the privacy and confidentiality declaration printed out from the privacy e-learning module and will provide both documents to the school to keep on file. Instructors of student groups who teach multiple terms at St. Joseph's must complete this e-learning annually.

Please note: Requirements #3 - #5 above do not apply to clinical instructors who are employees of St. Joseph's Health Care London. However, there is still a need to complete Requirements #1 and #2, and to send proof of immunizations to you School and your LearningEdge Certifications report to Student Affairs.
